WHAT QUALIFIES AS AN FOA EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM?

70% OF YOUR MEMBERS MUST BE THERE FOR THE ENTIRE PRESENTATION – ACTIVE AND ENGAGED ! (THIS 70% ENCOMPASSES ALL MEMBERS – ACTIVE OR NEW)

PROGRAM MUST BE ONE HOUR LONG & INCLUDE AT LEAST 15 MINUTES OF INTERACTION (SMALL GROUP DISCUSSION, ACTIVITY, ETC.)

PROGRAM MUST HAVE APPROVED LEARNING OUTCOMES

ALL MEMBERS IN ATTENDANCE MUST BE RESPECTFUL

SPACE MUST BE CLEAN AND CONDUCIVE TO LEARNING

CONTACT WITH PRESENTERS MUST BE PROFESSIONAL & RESPECTFUL






